Kickball House Rules

1. Kicked balls that touch the ceiling netting will be scored as a foul ball. If the ball is caught the kicker will be called out.
2. Kicked balls that touch the ceiling netting will be scored as a foul ball. If the ball is not caught, the kicker will return to the plate to continue or called out if 3 foul balls have been called previous to this kick.
3. Kicked balls that are caught after touching any foul ball area, will be called foul and added to the kicker's count.
4. A kicked ball that would be scored as a foul ball (WAKA rules-Section 13, c) and is caught will be scored as an out to the kicker. Play will continue as usual on any existing base runners.
5. A kicked ball that would be scored as a foul ball (WAKA rules-Section 13, c), stays fair and is played on the ground may be played by the defense but only on the kicker. If no play is made against the kicker, the kicker will return to the plate to continue or called out if 3 foul balls have been called previous to this kick.
6. Kicked balls that touch above the marked lines on the outfield "wall" will be scored as marked (double, triple or homerun).
